## AN ACT

9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

13	Section 1617. Filing of Free Application for Federal Student
14	Aid as Graduation RequirementBeginning with the 2024-2025
15	school year, in addition to any other requirement under law as a
16	prerequisite to receiving a high school diploma from a public
17	high school, the parent or guardian of each student or, if a
18	student is at least 18 years of age or legally emancipated, the
19	student must comply with either of the following:
20	(1) File a Free Application for Federal Student Aid with the

- 2 (2) On a form developed by the Department of Education, in

3 consultation with the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance

- 4 Agency, sign and file with the student's school district a
- 5 statement that the parent, guardian or student, as applicable,
- 6 <u>understands the purpose of the Free Application for Federal</u>
- 7 <u>Student Aid or has chosen not to file the application.</u>
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
