Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in 911 emergency communication 2 services, further providing for uniform 911 surcharge and for 3 termination. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 5306.2 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 5306.2. Uniform 911 surcharge. 9 * * * 10 11 (a.1) Surcharge increase. -- Beginning January 1, 2024, the 12 surcharge of \$1.65 assessed under subsection (a) shall increase 13 to \$1.97 and be adjusted annually each year thereafter by a 14 percentage equal to the upward percentage change in the Consumer 15 Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for which figures 16 have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The following shall apply: 17

(1) The surcharge increase shall be rounded to the

nearest 1¢.

- 1 (2) The percentage change of the surcharge increase
- 2 shall be determined by comparison of the figures for the
- 3 previous June with the current June figures.
- 4 (3) The surcharge increase shall be applied to the next
- 5 <u>successive calendar year. If the percentage change in the</u>
- 6 <u>Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U)</u>
- 7 <u>declines, the amount of the surcharge shall remain unchanged</u>
- 8 <u>for the successive calendar year.</u>
- 9 <u>(4) The agency shall, within 10 days of determining the</u>
- 10 surcharge increase, transmit a notice of the determination to
- 11 <u>the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the next</u>
- available issue of the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
