AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in school security, providing for 5 school security personnel. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 11 section to read: 12 Section 1316-C. School security personnel. 13 (a) School day. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 14 beginning in the 2023-2024 WITH THE 2024-2025 school year, a 15 school entity shall have one armed school security personnel on 16 duty during the school day at each school building. 17 (b) Extracurricular activities. -- A governing body of a 18 school entity may decide to have an armed school security

personnel on duty at the school campus IN A SCHOOL BUILDING OR <--

ON SCHOOL PREMISES during extracurricular activities that occur

- 1 outside of the school day.
- 2 (c) Certification. -- A school entity must certify to the
- 3 School Safety and Security Committee that an armed school
- 4 <u>security personnel satisfies the requirements of this article.</u>
- 5 (d) Powers and duties.--
- 6 (1) School police officers shall have the powers and
- 7 <u>duties provided under section 1302-C.</u>
- 8 (2) School resource officers shall have the powers and
- 9 <u>duties provided under section 1313-C.</u>
- 10 (3) School security quards shall have the powers and
- 11 duties provided under section 1314-C.
- 12 <u>(4) School security personnel may have other duties as</u>
- 13 <u>assigned by the school entity.</u>
- (e) Funding. -- Money allocated to the School Safety and
- 15 <u>Security Fund for the School Safety and Security Grant Program</u>
- 16 may be used for the requirements of this section.
- 17 (f) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 18 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 19 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 20 <u>"School campus." The grounds and buildings of a school that</u> <--
- 21 <u>is, or is part of, a school entity.</u>
- 22 "SCHOOL BUILDING." A BUILDING OWNED BY OR UNDER THE CONTROL <--
- 23 OF A SCHOOL ENTITY WHERE CLASSES ARE TAUGHT OR EXTRACURRICULAR
- 24 ACTIVITIES ARE CONDUCTED ON A REGULAR BASIS.
- 25 "School day." The hours between the morning opening of a
- 26 school building and the afternoon dismissal of students on a day

- 27 <u>which classes are in session on the school campus.</u>
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
