Civil penalties. 10 (a) Authorization. --11 The commissioner shall expunge the disciplinary 12 13 record of a licensee, registrant, certificate holder or permit holder if the imposition of discipline was for a 14 15 violation involving failure to complete continuing education 16 requirements or practicing for six months or less on a lapsed 17 license, registration, certificate or permit or for a

violation otherwise specified in the schedule of civil
