AN ACT

1 Amending Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed))
2 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and
3 duties, further providing for civil penalties.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3108(a)(2) introductory paragraph and (i)
7 of Title 63 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are
8 amended to read:

9 § 3108. Civil penalties.

10 (a) Authorization.--

11 * * *

12 (2) The commissioner shall expunge the disciplinary
13 record of a licensee, registrant, certificate holder or
14 permit holder if the imposition of discipline was for a
15 violation involving failure to complete continuing education
16 requirements or practicing for six months or less on a lapsed
17 license, registration, certificate or permit or for a
18 violation otherwise specified in the schedule of civil

1 penalties under paragraph (1), subject to the following:

2 (i) The licensee, registrant, certificate holder or
3 permit holder must make written application to the
4 commissioner for expungement not earlier than [~~four~~] five
5 years from the final disposition of the disciplinary
6 record.

8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
