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SECOND CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILLS

376 An Act amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, in casualty insurance, further providing for conditions subject to which policies are to be issued and for health insurance coverage for certain children of insured parents. (Representatives PASHINSKI, FRANKEL, KHAN and others) - **Insurance, March 24, 2025** **1**

This bill allows parents to keep adult children on the parent's health insurance policy until age 26, if the Federal Affordable Care Act goes away.

528 An Act providing for health care insurance coverage protections; imposing duties on the Insurance Department and the Insurance Commissioner; and imposing penalties. (Representatives FRANKEL, VENKAT, MERSKI and others) - **Insurance, March 24, 2025** **1**

This bill prohibits health insurers from imposing lifetime or annual dollar limits on essential medical care, if the Federal Affordable Care Act goes away.

618 An Act providing for health insurance access protections; imposing duties on the Insurance Department and the Insurance Commissioner; and imposing penalties. (Representatives HADDOCK, KINKEAD, HILL-EVANS and others) - **Insurance, March 24, 2025** **1**

This bill prohibits health insurance policies from imposing pre-existing conditions exclusions, if the Federal Affordable Care Act goes away.

779 An Act providing for health care insurance preventive services coverage protections; conferring authority on the Insurance Department and the Insurance Commissioner; and providing for regulations, for enforcement and for penalties. This bill requires health insurance policies to provide coverage of preventive health care services, if the Federal Affordable Care Act goes away.

334 An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child custody, further providing for factors to consider when awarding custody. (Representatives HANBIDGE, BRIGGS, KHAN and others) - **Judiciary, March 17, 2025** **4**

This bill streamlines the Child Custody Determination Factors.

261 An Act providing for workplace health and safety standards for public employees; providing for powers and duties of the Secretary of Labor and Industry; establishing the Pennsylvania Occupational Safety and Health Review Board; providing for workplace inspections; and imposing penalties. (Representatives HARKINS, MEHAFFIE, GIRAL and others) - **Labor & Industry, March 18, 2025** **3**

This bill creates OSHA for public employees modeled after the federal version.
