An Act amending the act of December 19, 1990 (P.L.1372, No.212), known as the Early Intervention Services System Act, further providing for title of the act, for definitions and for child identification, assessment and tracking system; and making editorial changes. (Representatives TOOHIL, SCHLOSSBERG, BOBACK and others) - Children & Youth, June 6, 2017


#### SECOND CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILL

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in consolidated county assessment, further providing for short title and scope of chapter and for appeals by taxing districts and providing for standards of redress in appeals. (Representatives KAMPF, GODSHALL, McGINNIS and others) - Commerce, May 22, 2017 5



HOUSE **332** An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further **356** providing for classes of income. (Representatives GROVE, BLOOM, NELSON and others) - Finance, May 9, 2017 7

This bill provides for classes of income.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION **GAMING OVERSIGHT BILL**

HOUSE An Act amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, 864 No.156), known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, 970 in preliminary provisions, further providing for legislative intent and for definitions; in games of chance, providing for airport 50/50 drawing; and, in enforcement, further providing for enforcement. (Representatives MUSTIO, D. COSTA, DeLUCA and others) - Gaming Oversight, June 5, 2017 2

This bill amends the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act to allow non-profits affiliated with an international airport to hold 50/50 raffles within the airport.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILL



An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in fiscal provisions relating to public assistance, providing for distribution of SNAP benefits. (Representatives TOOHIL, D. COSTA, DAVIS and others) – Health, May 23, 2017 4

*This bill amends the Human Services Code to require a uniform distribution of SNAP benefits over a 25-day distribution schedule.* 

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION HUMAN SERVICES BILL

HOUSE 119 1666 An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, providing for certified drug and alcohol recovery houses and establishing the Certified Drug and Alcohol Recovery House Fund. (Representatives KAUFER, DAVIS, READSHAW and others) - Human Services, June 6, 2017

This bill establishes standards for the certification of all drug and alcohol recovery houses that receive state or federal funds and to monitor/inspect recovery houses to ensure compliance.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILLS

HOUSE 1286 1789 An Act amending the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), known as the Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare) Act, in medical professional liability, providing for punitive damages study. (Representatives MENTZER, ZIMMERMAN, HICKERNELL and others) - Insurance, June 5, 2017 2

This bill provides for punitive damages study.

HOUSE 1388 1749 An Act amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, in comprehensive health care for uninsured children, further providing for expiration. (Representatives IRVIN, M. QUINN, DeLUCA and others) - Insurance, June 6, 2017 1

This bill provides for expiration.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE 1111 1699 A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives CUTLER, DEAN, DRISCOLL and others) - Judiciary, May 22, 2017 5

This bill is a summary of proposed legislation and is prepared only as general information for use by the Republican Members and staff of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives.

HOUSE

**274 1497** An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in protection from abuse, further providing for relief. (Representatives MARSICO, READSHAW, KNOWLES and others) – Judiciary, May 9, 2017 7

This bill amends the Protection From Abuse Act to add another type of relief for the plaintiff by allowing the court to order the defendant to refrain from abusing the plaintiff's cat or dog.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1287 1562 An Act authorizing the Department of General Services, with the approval of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission and the Governor, to grant and convey to the Warrior Run-Fort Freeland Heritage Society certain lands situate in Delaware Township, Northumberland County. (Representative SCHLEGEL CULVER) - State Government, June 6, 2017 1

*This bill authorizes the conveyance of land in Delaware Township, Northumberland County.* 

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE 831 1840 An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions relating to operation of vehicles, further providing for obedience to authorized persons directing traffic and providing for drivers in organized motorcycle processions; and, in rules of the road in general, further providing for following too closely. (Representatives M. K. KELLER, READSHAW, BARBIN and others) - Transportation, June 6, 2017


This bill amends the Vehicle Code to provide rights to organize motorcycle processions and to limit systematic vehicle inspection programs to commercial motor vehicles. VOTE

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, further 750 providing for reimbursement for certain medical assistance items and services. (Representatives CAUSER, BAKER, BARBIN and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, June 6, 2017
