

An Act amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in contract carrier by motor vehicle and broker, further providing for declaration of policy and definitions; and, in violations and penalties, further providing for unauthorized operation by carriers and brokers. (Representatives DAY, KNOWLES, D. COSTA and others) - Consumer Affairs, May 22, 2017 14

This bill amends Title 66 to increase penalties for unlicensed household goods movers operating in the Commonwealth.



HOUSE An Act amending the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), 1286 known as the Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error 1789 (Mcare) Act, in medical professional liability, providing for punitive damages study. (Representatives MENTZER, ZIMMERMAN, HICKERNELL and others) - Insurance, June 5, 2017 11

This bill provides for punitive damages study.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and 1699 adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives CUTLER, DEAN, DRISCOLL and others) - Judiciary, May 22, 2017 14

This bill is a summary of proposed legislation and is prepared only as general information for use by the Republican Members and staff of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE 274 1497 An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in protection from abuse, further providing for relief. (Representatives MARSICO, READSHAW, KNOWLES and others) - Judiciary, June 22, 2017 1

This bill amends the Protection From Abuse Act to add another type of relief for the plaintiff by allowing the court to order the defendant to refrain from abusing the plaintiff's cat or dog.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 1469 2016 An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in adoption and enforcement by municipalities, further providing for administration and enforcement. (Representatives HEFFLEY, McGINNIS, MILLARD and others) - Rules, June 21, 2017 2

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to require that building permit applications in municipalities using one or more third party agency to enforce the Uniform Construction Code, contain a written notice on where complaints can be directed about the performance of such agencies.

HOUSE 641 1712 An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assessments of persons and property, providing for senior property tax freeze. (Representatives GROVE, SCHWEYER, JAMES and others) – Local Government, June 7, 2017 9

This bill establishes an Optional Senior Property Tax Freeze program.
