(Senators MENSCH, BARTOLOTTA, GREENLEAF and others) – Appropriations, June 26, 2017

An Act providing for the capital budget for fiscal year 2017-2018; itemizing public improvement projects, furniture and equipment projects, transportation assistance projects, redevelopment assistance, flood control projects, Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund projects, Environmental Stewardship Fund projects, State forestry bridge projects, park and forest management projects, State ATV/Snowmobile Fund projects, Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission projects, Oil and Gas Lease Fund projects and Motor License Fund projects to be constructed, acquired or assisted by the Department of General Services, the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, the Department of **Environmental Protection, the Department of Transportation or** the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission, together with their estimated financial costs; authorizing the incurring of debt without the approval of the electors for the purpose of financing the projects to be constructed, acquired or assisted by the Department of General Services, the Department of Environmental Protection, the Department of Transportation or the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission; authorizing the use of current revenue for the purpose of financing the projects to be constructed, acquired or assisted by

HOUSE 1213 1486

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in consolidated county assessment, further providing for short title and scope of chapter and for appeals by taxing districts and providing for standards of redress in appeals. (Representatives KAMPF, GODSHALL, McGINNIS and others) - Commerce, May 22, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for short title and scope of chapter and for appeals by taxing districts.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 179

An Act amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in contract carrier by motor vehicle and broker, further providing for declaration of policy and definitions; and, in violations and penalties, further providing for unauthorized operation by carriers and brokers. (Representatives DAY, KNOWLES, D. COSTA and others) - Consumer Affairs, May 22, 2017

OVER

This bill amends Title 66 to increase penalties for unlicensed household goods movers operating in the Commonwealth.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

HOUSE 332

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives GROVE, BLOOM, NELSON and others) – Finance, June 22, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for classes of income.

SECOND CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILLS

HOUSE 1286

An Act amending the act of March 20, 2002 (P.L.154, No.13), known as the Medical Care Availability and Reduction of Error (Mcare) Act, in medical professional liability, providing for punitive damages study. (Representatives MENTZER, ZIMMERMAN, HICKERNELL and others) – Insurance, June 5, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for punitive damages study.

HOUSE 1576 2064

An Act amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), known as The Insurance Department Act of 1921, providing for limited lines travel insurance. (Representatives PICKETT AND DeLUCA) - Rules, June 21, 2017

OVER

This bill provides for limited lines travel insurance.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE

1699 a

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives CUTLER, DEAN, DRISCOLL and others) – Judiciary, May 22, 2017

OVER

This bill is a summary of proposed legislation and is prepared only as general information for use by the Republican Members and staff of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives.

HOUSE

2 / 4 1497 An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in protection from abuse, further providing for relief. (Representatives MARSICO, READSHAW, KNOWLES and others) – Judiciary, June 22, 2017

OVER

This bill amends the Protection From Abuse Act to add another type of relief for the plaintiff by allowing the court to order the defendant to refrain from abusing the plaintiff's cat or dog.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 1469 2016

An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in adoption and enforcement by municipalities, further providing for administration and enforcement. (Representatives HEFFLEY, McGINNIS, MILLARD and others) - Rules, June 21, 2017

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to require that building permit applications in municipalities using one or more third party agency to enforce the Uniform Construction Code, contain a written notice on where complaints can be directed about the performance of such agencies.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 641 1712

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assessments of persons and property, providing for senior property tax freeze. (Representatives GROVE, SCHWEYER, JAMES and others) – Local Government, June 7, 2017

OVER

This bill establishes an Optional Senior Property Tax Freeze program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1175 1398

An Act amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in lobbying disclosure, further providing for registration, for reporting, for prohibited activities, for penalties and for registration fees, fund established, system and regulations. (Representatives CUTLER, NEUMAN, MATZIE and others) – State Government, June 26, 2017

SENATE 288

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in rules of the road in general, further providing for duty of driver in emergency response areas. (Senators RAFFERTY, McGARRIGLE, BREWSTER and others) - Transportation, June 26, 2017

An Act designating a bridge on that portion of old State Route 22 over the Conemaugh River in Blairsville Borough, Indiana County, as the Blairsville Area Veterans Memorial Bridge; designating that portion of State Route 4027, also known as Business U.S. Route 220, over the Norfolk Southern mainline railroad tracks in Grazierville, Snyder Township, Blair County, as the John Fredrick Bridges Memorial Bridge; designating the bridge, identified as Bridge Key 53825, on that portion of State Route 1011, also known as Castile Run Road, over the South Fork Tenmile Creek between Jefferson Township and Clarksville Borough, Greene County, as the PFC Brent A. McClellan Memorial Bridge; designating a bridge on that portion of U.S. Route 11 over the Susquehanna River between the City of Pittston and West Pittston Borough, Luzerne County, as the Specialist Dale J. Kridlo Memorial Bridge; designating a bridge at the junction of State Route 150 and State Route 64 over Fishing Creek in Mill Hall Borough, Clinton County, as the U.S. Navy SOC David M. Collins Veterans Memorial Bridge: designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 2014 over Lycoming Creek, City of Williamsport, Lycoming County, as the Alexander M. McFadden Memorial Bridge; and designating a bridge on that portion of State Route 85 over the north branch of Plum Creek, Plumville Borough, Indiana County, as the Henry Lue Weaver Memorial Bridge. (Senator WHITE) - Transportation, June 26, 2017
