SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILL

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, March 12, 2019

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILLS

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in preliminary provisions, providing for career information and recruitment. (Representatives MAKO, BERNSTINE, DUNBAR and others) – Education, March 18, 2019 2 VOTE

This bill provides for educational or career opportunities and employment training for Career and Technical Education (CTE) for students grade 4 through 12.

SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILLS



An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14),
known as the Public School Code of 1949, in vocational education,
providing for an online career resource center. (Representatives HARKINS, ROEBUCK, KINSEY and others) - Education, March 18, 2019

This bill creates an online career resource center for Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs.

HOUSE 395 746 An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in vocational education, further providing for advisory committees. (Representatives ROEBUCK, MILLARD, HILL-EVANS and others) – Education, March 19, 2019 1

This bill requires the Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs to establish occupational advisory committees.

An Act amending the act of December 18, 2001 (P.L.949, No.114), known as the Workforce Development Act, in local workforce investment areas and boards, further providing for membership. (Representatives ROEBUCK, MILLARD, HILL-EVANS and others) – Education, March 19, 2019 1



This bill adds at least one member to each Workforce Development Board through Career and Technical Education (CTE).

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

An Act amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., **P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, making editorial changes to incorrect references.** (Representatives EMRICK, BERNSTINE, HAHN and others) – Finance, March 19, 2019 1



This bill provides for Property Tax Relief Act and makes editorial changes to incorrect references.

SECOND CONSIDERATION GAME AND FISHERIES BILLS



An Act amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
Statutes, in fishing licenses, further providing for exemptions from license requirements. (Representatives KORTZ, GILLESPIE, KULIK and others) - Game & Fisheries, March 19, 2019



VOTE

This bill provides for specific license exemption for participants in organized therapeutic fishing activities.

612 An Act amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, providing for a volunteer instructor license. (Representatives GILLESPIE, MURT, McNEILL and others) - Game & Fisheries, March 19, 2019 1

This bill provides for a discounted general hunting license for Hunter Trapper Education (THE) Instructors by creating a "Volunteer Instructor License".

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILLS

An Act amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, in determination of compensation, appeals, reviews and procedure, further providing for determination of compensation appeals and for decision of referee and further appeals and reviews. (Representatives JAMES, BARRAR, BENNINGHOFF and others) - Labor & Industry, March 19, 2019 1

This bill amends the Unemployment Compensation (UC) Law to increase the time allotted (from 15 days to 21 days) to appeal the determination of a UC Service Center or the decision of a UC referee.

HOUSE 425 882 An Act providing for school-to-work programs; establishing the CareerBound program; and imposing powers and duties on the Department of Labor and Industry. (Representatives MACKENZIE, BERNSTINE, FEE and others) - Labor & Industry, March 19, 2019 1

This bill creates a freestanding act which establishes the CareerBound program, a school-to-work pilot program.





SECOND CONSIDERATION **PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE BILLS**

An Act amending the act of July 2, 1993 (P.L.345, No.48), 68 entitled "An act empowering the General Counsel or his designee to issue subpoenas for certain licensing board activities; providing for hearing examiners in the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs; providing additional powers to the **Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs; and further** providing for civil penalties and license suspension," further providing for civil penalties. (Representatives READSHAW, LONGIETTI, KORTZ and others) - Professional Licensure, March 19, 2019 1

This bill authorizes the state professional and occupational licensing boards to allow carryover of excess continuing education credits.

HOUSE 138 An Act amending the act of October 10, 1975 (P.L.383, No.110), known as the Physical Therapy Practice Act, further providing for 131 qualifications for license and examinations for physical therapists and physical therapist assistants. (Representatives QUINN, JAMES, McNEILL and others) - Professional Licensure, March 19, 2019

This bill authorizes students in physical therapist and physical therapist assistant educational programs to sit for their licensure/certification examination up to 90 days prior to graduation.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **TRANSPORTATION BILL**

An Act amending Titles 27 (Environmental Resources) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for **347** Keystone Tree Fund; and, in registration of vehicles, providing for contributions to the Keystone Tree Fund. (Representatives EVERETT, SOLOMON, PASHINSKI and others) - Transportation, February 21. 2019 6

This bill amends Title 27 & 75 to provide for Keystone Tree Fund.

RESOLUTION

A Resolution urging the Congress of the United States to pass, and the President of the United States to sign, legislation that will 710 make apprenticeships more affordable for individuals seeking a skills-based education. (Representatives KLUNK, KINSEY, LONGIETTI and others) - Finance, March 18, 2019 2
