SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILL

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, March 12, 2019 5

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in Treasury Department, further providing for investment of moneys. (Representatives KAUFER, READSHAW, RYAN and others) – Finance, March 20, 2019 1



This bill extends the Prudent Person Investment Standard, in Treasury Department, to 2021.

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing 99 for the offense of sale of tobacco and for the offense of use of tobacco in schools. (Representatives RAPP, REESE, KAUFFMAN and others) - Judiciary, March 20, 2019



This bill amends Title 18 to prohibit the sale or purchase of vaping products to or by minors and to prohibit the use of vaping products on school grounds.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for 856 definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) - Labor & Industry, March 20, 2019 1

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania **Consolidated Statutes, in intergovernmental** 885 cooperation, further providing for ordinance, for content of ordinance, for joint purchases with private educational establishments, for required review of specified agreements and for effect of joint cooperation agreements. (Representatives SCHEMEL, SAYLOR, MILLARD and others) - Local Government, March 20, 2019

This bill amends the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act to authorize the use of resolutions to enter into such agreements.

HOUSE An Act amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, in corporate powers, **497** further providing for intergovernmental cooperation. (Representatives SCHEMEL, SAYLOR, MILLARD and others) - Local Government. March 20, 2019



This bill amends the Second Class Township Code to authorize the use of resolutions to enter into Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreements.


