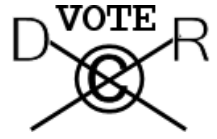

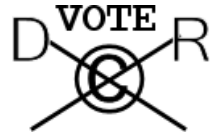


This bill provides for Olympics Income Tax exemption.

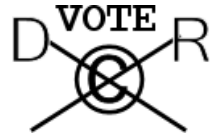

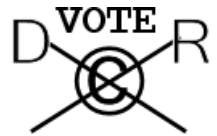


This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

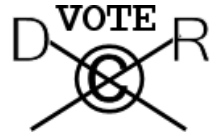

This bill amends the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Compact between Pennsylvania and New Jersey to provide the Governor with veto power over Commission members; to specify the process for the delivery to and return of the Commission's meeting minutes to the Governor; and to change auditing requirements.

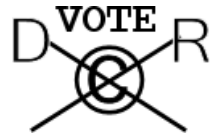
