This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to require that municipalities, which opt to enforce to Uniform Construction Code (UCC) by utilizing third-party agencies, have at least two or more contracted for UCC administration.

856 An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) - **Labor & Industry, March 20, 2019** **4**

OVER

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.
