SECOND CONSIDERATION AGING AND OLDER ADULT SERVICES BILL

HOUSE **375**

An Act amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, in pharmaceutical assistance for the elderly, further providing for definitions. (Representatives GOODMAN, CALTAGIRONE, FITZGERALD and others) - Aging & Older Adult Services, May 8, 2019

OVER

This bill amends the act of August 26,1971, known as the State Lottery Law, in pharmaceutical assistance for the elderly, further providing for definitions.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILL

HOUSE **309**

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, April 30, 2019

OVER

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILLS

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well
permits. (Representatives OBERLANDER, FRITZ, JAMES and
others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, March 25,
2019

OVER

This bill amends Title 58 to provide for cross unit drilling.

HOUSE 827

An Act designating certain activity by the Delaware River Basin Commission as the exercise of the power of eminent domain that entitles the owners of the property in question to appropriate and just compensation. (Representatives FRITZ, JAMES, PICKETT and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, May 7, 2019



This bill establishes the Delaware River Basin Commission Eminent Domain Activity Act to provide for compensation for DRBC takings.

SECOND CONSIDERATION GAME AND FISHERIES BILL

HOUSE **615**

An Act amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in retirement for State employees and officers, further defining "enforcement officer." (Representatives GILLESPIE, KORTZ, KULIK and others) - Game & Fisheries, May 08, 2019



This bill provides for inclusion of Game Commission officers under the definition of Enforcement Officer in the State Employees Retirement Code.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILLS

321

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in abortion, further providing for definitions and for medical consultation and judgment. (Representatives KLUNK, TURZAI, BARRAR and others) – Health, May 08, 2019



This bill amends the Abortion Control Act to prohibit abortion based on a diagnosis of Down Syndrome.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILLS

HOUSE 427

An Act providing for health insurance coverage requirements for stage four, advanced metastatic cancer. (Representatives BENNINGHOFF, BARRAR, BERNSTINE and others) – Health, April 8, 2019

OVER

This bill is a freestanding act which addresses treatment of stage four, advanced metastatic cancer.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1111

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives SCHEMEL, McCLINTON, SIMS and others) - Judiciary, May 06, 2019

OVER

This bill is a Joint Resolution amending Article V of the PA Constitution to provide for the appointment of justices to the Supreme Court and judges to the Superior and Commonwealth Courts and establishing the Appellate Court Nominating Commission.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE **785**

An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) – Labor & Industry, May 8, 2019

OVER

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE 917

An Act repealing the act of May 17, 1929 (P.L.1805, No.598), entitled "An act authorizing municipalities other than townships to 1055 acquire by gift, devise, or bequest, lands, chattels, securities and funds for the establishment and maintenance of a hospital; to appoint trustees of such property and funds, subject to the approval of the orphans' court; to operate and maintain such hospital through and by means of such trustees; and to expend municipal funds to aid in the establishment and maintenance of such hospital." (Representatives SCHMITT, DIAMOND, RYAN and others) - Local Government, May 08, 2019



This bill repeals Act 598 of 1929 which authorized the creation of municipal hospitals.

HOUSE 1074 1614

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, providing for governing bodies of airport authorities located in **counties of the second class.** (Representatives TURZAI, HENNESSEY, RYAN and others) - Local Government, May 1, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class.

SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 633

An Act amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, in primary and election 628 expenses, further providing for reporting by candidate and political committees and other persons, for late contributions and independent expenditures, for place of filing and for additional powers and duties of the Secretary of the Commonwealth. (Representatives M. K. KELLER, BRIGGS, BERNSTINE and others) - State Government,

OVER

This bill provides for reporting by candidate and political committees and other persons, for late contributions and independent expenditures.

(Representatives EVERETT, SOLOMON, PASHINSKI and others) - Transportation, April 17, 2019



(Representatives GOODMAN, KNOWLES, TOBASH and others) - Transportation, May 7, 2019

(Representatives BARRAR, SAINATO, O'NEAL and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, May 08, 2019
