#### SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 881

An Act amending the act of June 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for the administration of certain 1434 Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program. (Representatives FEE, RYAN, BERNSTINE others) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, June 28, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for the administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION **CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS**

**HOUSE** 309

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, June 12, 2019

OVER

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS

HOUSE 1633

An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for employees having contact with children; adoptive and foster parents. (Representative BOBACK) - Rules, June 24, 2019

**OVER** 

This bill amends the Child Protective Services Law to provide for additional background check requirements and to restrict provisional employment arrangements.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILLS

HOUSE 1102

An Act establishing the Keystone Energy Authority; and providing for the designation of Keystone Energy Enhancement Zones. (Representatives KAIL, TURZAI, KAUFER and others) - Commerce, September 24, 2019

VOTE

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This bill establishes the Keystone Energy Authority and providing for the designation of Keystone Enhancement Zones.

HOUSE

1104 1597

An Act amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in preliminary provisions, providing for Abandoned Manufacturing Sites Registry. (Representatives TOOHIL, TURZAI, KAUFER and others) - Rules, September 23, 2019

VOTE



This bill provides for Abandoned Manufacturing Sites Registry.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

**HOUSE 247** 

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well permits. (Representatives OBERLANDER, FRITZ, JAMES and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, June 24, 2019 10

**OVER** 

This bill amends Title 58 to provide for cross unit drilling.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 111 1630

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives SCHEMEL, McCLINTON, SIMS and others) – Judiciary, June 18, 2019

**OVER** 

This bill is a Joint Resolution amending Article V of the PA Constitution to provide for the appointment of justices to the Supreme Court and judges to the Superior and Commonwealth Courts and establishing the Appellate Court Nominating Commission.

## SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

**HOUSE 785** 

An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) - Labor & Industry, June 20, 2019 11

**OVER** 

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS

HOUSE 1074

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, providing for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class. (Representatives TURZAI, HENNESSEY, RYAN and others) – Local Government, June 17, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class.

HOUSE

1243 1447 An Act amending the act of April 23, 2002 (P.L.298, No.39), known as the Main Street Act, further providing for the duration of grants. (Representatives FREEMAN, JAMES, SCHLOSSBERG and others) - Local Government, September 24, 2019

VOTE

This bill provides for the duration of grants.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1107 2506

An Act amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, establishing the Pennsylvania Permitting Commission and providing for its powers and duties. (Representatives O'NEAL, TURZAI, KAUFER and others) - State Government, September 24, 2019



This bill transfers the duties of the Department of Environmental Protection relating to the issuance, modification, renewal and transfer of individual permits and authorizations to proceed under a general permit or plan approval to a newly created Pennsylvania Permitting Commission.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILL

HOUSE 37

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for learners' permits; in rules of the road in general, repealing provisions relating to prohibiting text-based communications, prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices, imposing penalties and establishing the Distracted Driver Awareness Fund; and, in operation of vehicles miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle and for the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle. (Representatives BROWN, READSHAW, STEPHENS and others) - Rules, September 19, 2019

**OVER** 

This bill prohibits the use of hand-held interactive wireless communication devices while operating a motor vehicle.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION URBAN AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 122

An Act amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in home inspections, further providing for home inspection reports. (Representatives KORTZ, HELM, READSHAW and others) – Urban Affairs, September 23, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for home inspection reports.

### THIRD CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 1037

An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions and for application; and, in exemptions, applicability and penalties, further providing for penalties. (Representatives LAWRENCE, CAUSER, BERNSTINE and others) - Appropriations, June 26, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

**OVER** 

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to exempt historic agricultural buildings, when used for private events and meeting certain safety provisions, from the provisions of the code.

#### THIRD CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILL

HOUSE 1410 2161

An Act amending the act of December 8, 2004 (P.L.1801, No.238), known as the Transit Revitalization Investment District Act, in general provisions, further providing for declaration of policy and for definitions; providing for military installation remediation; and establishing the Military Installation Remediation Fund. (Representatives STEPHENS, KENYATTA, ULLMAN and others) - Appropriations, June 18, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached



This bill provides for military installation remediation and establishes the Military Installation Remediation Fund.

## THIRD CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILL

HOUSE 1283

An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in judgments and other liens, further providing for exemption of particular property. (Representatives MOUL, PICKETT, RYAN and others) - Appropriations, September 17, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill amends Title 40 and Title 42 to provide consumer protections for annuity benefit plans.

## THIRD CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

**196** 

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organizing the Judiciary into representative districts and further providing for residency requirements. (Representatives DIAMOND, BERNSTINE, CAUSER and others) – Appropriations, June 24, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

**OVER** 

This bill proposes integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organizing the Judiciary into representative districts and further providing for residency requirements.

## THIRD CONSIDERATION STATE GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1316

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, providing for spending limitations on the Commonwealth. (Representatives WARNER AND HERSHEY) - Appropriations, September 23, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill amends the Constitution to establish limitations on the spending of Commonwealth funds.
