### SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 881

An Act amending the act of June 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for the administration of certain 1434 Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program. (Representatives FEE, RYAN, BERNSTINE others) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, June 28, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for the administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION **CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS**

**HOUSE** 309

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, **September 24, 2019** 

OVER

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS

HOUSE 1633

An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for employees having contact with children; adoptive and foster parents. (Representative BOBACK) - Rules, June 24, 2019


**OVER** 

This bill amends the Child Protective Services Law to provide for additional background check requirements and to restrict provisional employment arrangements.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILL

HOUSE 1102

An Act establishing the Keystone Energy Authority; and providing for the designation of Keystone Energy Enhancement Zones. (Representatives KAIL, TURZAI, KAUFER and others) - Commerce, September 24, 2019



This bill establishes the Keystone Energy Authority and providing for the designation of Keystone Enhancement Zones.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well permits. (Representatives OBERLANDER, FRITZ, JAMES and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, June 24, 2019 11

**OVER** 

This bill amends Title 58 to provide for cross unit drilling.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1630

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives SCHEMEL, McCLINTON, SIMS and others) – Judiciary, June 18, 2019

OVER

This bill is a Joint Resolution amending Article V of the PA Constitution to provide for the appointment of justices to the Supreme Court and judges to the Superior and Commonwealth Courts and establishing the Appellate Court Nominating Commission.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

**HOUSE 785** 

An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), **856** known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) - Labor & Industry, June 20, 2019

OVER

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

### **SECOND CONSIDERATION** LIQUOR CONTROL BILLS

**HOUSE** 

An Act amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, in licenses and regulations for liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages, further providing for sale of malt or brewed beverages by liquor licensees. (Representatives KNOWLES, RYAN, SNYDER and others) - Liquor Control, **September 25, 2019** 

VOTE

This bill eliminates the license surcharge contained in the Liquor Code for veteran organizations and volunteer fire companies.

**HOUSE** 

**1542** 

An Act amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, in licenses and regulations relating to 2513 liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages, further providing for special occasion permits. (Representatives SAYLOR, PYLE, GILLESPIE and others) - Liquor Control, September 25, 2019

VOTE

This bill amends the Liquor Code to add days for holders of special occasion permits.

**HOUSE** 

An Act amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, in licenses and regulations, liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages, further providing for sales by liquor licensees, restrictions, for public venue license and for performing acts facility license. (Representatives SAMUELSON, McNEILL, DEASY and others) - Liquor Control, September 25, 2019

This bill amends the Liquor Code to extend the hours of operation for public venues and performing arts facilities.

#### **SECOND CONSIDERATION** LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

**HOUSE** 1074

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, providing for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class. (Representatives TURZAI, HENNESSEY, RYAN and others) - Local Government, June 17, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class.

### **SECOND CONSIDERATION** TRANSPORTATION BILL

**HOUSE** 

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 2058 Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, and in definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for learners' permits; in rules of the road in general, repealing provisions relating to prohibiting text-based communications, prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices, imposing penalties and establishing the Distracted Driver Awareness Fund; and, in operation of vehicles miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle and for the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle. (Representatives BROWN, READSHAW, STEPHENS and others) - Rules, September 19, 2019

OVER

This bill prohibits the use of hand-held interactive wireless communication devices while operating a motor vehicle.

**HOUSE** 122

An Act amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in home inspections, further providing for home inspection reports. (Representatives KORTZ, HELM, READSHAW and others) - Urban Affairs, September 23,

OVER

This bill provides for home inspection reports.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL

SENATE **146** 

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing for online training for firefighters; and making a related repeal. (Senators BROOKS, SCARNATI, GORDNER and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, September 25, 2019

**OVER** 

This bill provides for Online Training for Firefighters.

### THIRD CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 1037

An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions and for application; and, in exemptions, applicability and penalties, further providing for penalties. (Representatives LAWRENCE, CAUSER, BERNSTINE and others) - Appropriations, June 26, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached


OVER

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to exempt historic agricultural buildings, when used for private events and meeting certain safety provisions, from the provisions of the code.

## THIRD CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILL

HOUSE 1410 2161

An Act amending the act of December 8, 2004 (P.L.1801, No.238), known as the Transit Revitalization Investment District Act, in general provisions, further providing for declaration of policy and for definitions; providing for military installation remediation; and establishing the Military Installation Remediation Fund. (Representatives STEPHENS, KENYATTA, ULLMAN and others) - Appropriations, June 18, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached



This bill provides for military installation remediation and establishes the Military Installation Remediation Fund.

### THIRD CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILL

HOUSE 1283

An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in judgments and other liens, further providing for exemption of particular property. (Representatives MOUL, PICKETT, RYAN and others) - Appropriations, September 17, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

**OVER** 

This bill amends Title 40 and Title 42 to provide consumer protections for annuity benefit plans.

## THIRD CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

**HOUSE 196** 

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organizing the Judiciary into representative districts and further providing for residency requirements. 
