SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 881

An Act amending the act of June 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for the administration of certain 1434 Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program. (Representatives FEE, RYAN, BERNSTINE others) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, June 28, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for the administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS**

HOUSE 309

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, **September 24, 2019**

OVER

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS

HOUSE 1633

An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for employees having contact with children; adoptive and foster parents. (Representative BOBACK) - Rules, June 24, 2019

OVER

This bill amends the Child Protective Services Law to provide for additional background check requirements and to restrict provisional employment arrangements.

SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well permits. (Representatives OBERLANDER, FRITZ, JAMES and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, June 24, 2019 13

OVER

This bill amends Title 58 to provide for cross unit drilling.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 111 1630

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives SCHEMEL, McCLINTON, SIMS and others) - Judiciary, October 22, 2019

OVER

This bill is a Joint Resolution amending Article V of the PA Constitution to provide for the appointment of justices to the Supreme Court and judges to the Superior and Commonwealth Courts and establishing the Appellate Court Nominating Commission.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 785

An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) – Labor & Industry, June 20, 2019 14

OVER

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1074

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, providing for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class. (Representatives TURZAI, HENNESSEY, RYAN and others) - Local Government, October 21, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class.

SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILL

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 2058 Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, and in definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for learners' permits; in rules of the road in general, repealing provisions relating to prohibiting text-based communications, prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices, imposing penalties and establishing the Distracted Driver Awareness Fund; and, in operation of vehicles miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle and for the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle. (Representatives BROWN, READSHAW, STEPHENS and others) - Rules, September 19, 2019

OVER

This bill prohibits the use of hand-held interactive wireless communication devices while operating a motor vehicle.

HOUSE 122

An Act amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in home inspections, further providing for home inspection reports. (Representatives KORTZ, HELM, READSHAW and others) - Urban Affairs, September 23,

OVER

This bill provides for home inspection reports.

SECOND CONSIDERATION VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL

HOUSE 1673 2231

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in volunteer firefighters, further providing for definitions, for statement of purpose, for funds and for audits. (Representatives FARRY, BARRAR, DiGIROLAMO and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 21, 2019



This bill authorizes Volunteer Fire Departments to use Volunteer Fire Relief Funds for Length of Service Award programs, which are mini-retirement programs for volunteer firefighters.

HOUSE

1773 2364

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in emergency management services, providing for tuition assistance for active volunteers; and establishing the Active Volunteer Tuition Assistance Program and Active Volunteer Tuition Assistance Fund. (Representatives STRUZZI, FARRY, BARRAR and others) – Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 22, 2019



This bill establishes the First Responder Tuition Assistance Program.

HOUSE 1786 2509

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in incentives for municipal volunteers of fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical services agencies, establishing the First Responder Loan Forgiveness Program; and making editorial changes. (Representatives SAINATO, BARRAR, STRUZZI and others) – Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 21, 2019



This bill provides for the First Responder College Loan Forgiveness Program.

316 2473 An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, further providing for assistance to volunteer fire companies, ambulance service and rescue squads. This bill provides to increase the VLAP loan amounts.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL**

HOUSE 1839

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in incentives for municipal volunteers of fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical services agencies, further providing for definitions, for real property tax credit and for rejection and appeal. (Representatives BROOKS, OWLETT, ECKER and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 22, 2019

 \mathbf{VOTE}

This bill authorizes counties to provide a property tax credit of up to 100% for volunteer emergency responders.

(Representatives LAWRENCE, CAUSER, BERNSTINE and others) - Appropriations, June 26, 2019 Fiscal-Note **Attached**

OVER

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to exempt historic agricultural buildings, when used for private events and meeting certain safety provisions, from the provisions of the code.
