SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 881

An Act amending the act of June 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for the administration of certain 1434 Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program. (Representatives FEE, RYAN, BERNSTINE others) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, June 28, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for the administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within the Department of Agriculture," further providing for agricultural land conservation assistance grant program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS**

HOUSE 309

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in departmental powers and duties as to supervision, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants; and, in departmental powers and duties as to licensing, further providing for fees, providing for Keystone STARS Program participants and further providing for definition. (Representatives MEHAFFIE, SOLOMON, A. DAVIS and others) - Children & Youth, **September 24, 2019**

OVER

This bill requires child care facilities to publicly display their Keystone STARS rating.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CHILDREN AND YOUTH BILLS

HOUSE 1633

An Act amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for employees having contact with children; adoptive and foster parents. (Representative BOBACK) - Rules, June 24, 2019

OVER

This bill amends the Child Protective Services Law to provide for additional background check requirements and to restrict provisional employment arrangements.

SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

1005E 247

An Act amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, further providing for well permits. (Representatives OBERLANDER, FRITZ, JAMES and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, June 24, 2019 14

OVER

This bill amends Title 58 to provide for cross unit drilling.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 111 163

A Joint Resolution proposing integrated amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, changing and adding provisions relating to selection of justices and judges. (Representatives SCHEMEL, McCLINTON, SIMS and others) - Judiciary, October 22, 2019

OVER

This bill is a Joint Resolution amending Article V of the PA Constitution to provide for the appointment of justices to the Supreme Court and judges to the Superior and Commonwealth Courts and establishing the Appellate Court Nominating Commission.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 785

An Act amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, further providing for definitions; in employee rights, providing for payments to employee organizations; and making related repeals. (Representatives KLUNK, RYAN, MOUL and others) – Labor & Industry, June 20, 2019 15

OVER

This bill amends the Public Employe Relations Act to require specific disclosure of employee rights; repeals unenforceable laws related to fair share fees.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1074

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal authorities, providing for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class. (Representatives TURZAI, HENNESSEY, RYAN and others) - Local Government, October 21, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for governing bodies of airport authorities located in counties of the second class.

SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 2058 definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for learners' permits; in rules of the road in general, repealing provisions relating to prohibiting text-based communications, prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices, imposing penalties and establishing the Distracted Driver Awareness Fund; and, in operation of vehicles miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle and for the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle. (Representatives BROWN, READSHAW, STEPHENS and others) - Rules, September 19, 2019


OVER

This bill prohibits the use of hand-held interactive wireless communication devices while operating a motor vehicle.

HOUSE

1758

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fees, further providing for certified copies 2586 of records; and, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for reports by police. (Representatives ORTITAY, MILLARD, others) - Transportation, October 23, OBERLANDER and 2019



This bill amends Title 75 to exempt volunteer fire and ambulance companies from the vehicle accident report fee.

SECOND CONSIDERATION URBAN AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in home inspections, further providing for home inspection reports. (Representatives KORTZ, HELM, READSHAW and others) - Urban Affairs, September 23, 2019

OVER

This bill provides for home inspection reports.

SECOND CONSIDERATION VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL

HOUSE 432


An Act amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, in interpretation and definitions, further providing for definitions; and, in liability and compensation, further providing for compensation for post-traumatic stress injury. (Representatives BARRAR, SAINATO, BIZZARRO and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 23,



This bill requires post-traumatic stress injuries to be compensable under workers compensation for first responders, including 911 center dispatchers and call takers, and corrections officers.

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in emergency management services, providing for emergency response payment. (Representatives DUSH, JOZWIAK, GREINER and others) - Veterans Affairs & **Emergency Preparedness, October 23, 2019**



This bill authorizes Volunteer Fire Departments to bill for real and reasonable costs.

HOUSE

1347

An Act amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, in casualty insurance, further providing for billing. (Representatives MASSER, WHEELAND, IRVIN and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 23, 2019



This bill requires insurance carriers to reimburse ambulance companies directly that are not in the insurance carrier's network.

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in volunteer fire company, 1796 ambulance service and rescue squad assistance, providing for referendum to expand loan assistance. (Representatives STURLA, ZABEL, KINSEY and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 23, 2019



This bill authorizes a voter referendum asking the electorate for the incurring of debt by authorizing municipal fire departments to participate in the state administered Volunteer Loan Assistance Program.

HOUSE

An Act amending Titles 35 (Health and Safety) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for emergency responder mental wellness and stress management; establishing the Statewide Critical Incident Stress Management Program; providing for duties of the Secretary of Health and the Department of Health; in emergency medical services system, further providing for support

of emergency medical services; in operation of vehicles general provisions, further providing for EMS costs; and, in driving after imbibing alcohol or utilizing drugs, further providing for Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition. This bill provides for peer to peer counseling and an anonymous PTSI hotline for emergency responders.

HOUSE 1834

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in grants to fire companies and emergency medical services companies, further providing for award of grants and for expiration of authority; and establishing the Construction Savings Account. (Representatives SAINATO, SAPPEY, BARRAR and others) – Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 23, 2019



This bill reauthorizes the \$30 million Fire and EMS Grant Program for another 4 years.

HOUSE 1838 2523

An Act amending Titles 35 (Health and Safety) and 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in emergency medical services system, further providing for support of emergency medical services; in general provisions, further providing for EMS costs; and, in driving after imbibing alcohol or utilizing drugs, further providing for Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition. (Representatives CAUSER, BARRAR, SAINATO and others) – Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 23, 2019



This bill increases the traffic fines for EMSOF fund.

HOUSE 1869 2566

An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in emergency medical services system, further providing for basic life support ambulances. (Representatives OWLETT, BARRAR, CAUSER and others) – Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, October 23, 2019



This bill amends Title 35 by providing the Department of Health with the ability to grant Basic Life Support staffing waivers for 6th through 8th class counties.

HOUSE 1037

An Act amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions and for application; and, in exemptions, applicability and penalties, further providing for penalties. (Representatives LAWRENCE, CAUSER, BERNSTINE and others) - Appropriations, June 26, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill amends the PA Construction Code Act to exempt historic agricultural buildings, when used for private events and meeting certain safety provisions, from the provisions of the code.

An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in judgments and other liens, further providing for exemption of particular property. (Representatives MOUL, PICKETT, RYAN and others) – Appropriations, September 17, 2019 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill amends Title 40 and Title 42 to provide consumer protections for annuity benefit plans.
