### SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILLS

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) – Education, March 17, 2021

VOTE



This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

**365** 

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, making editorial changes. (Representatives HARKINS, GALLOWAY, SAMUELSON and others) - Education, March 17, 2021

VOTE



This bill amends the Public School Code to update outdated terminology to conform with modern usage.

**HOUSE** 

412

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in professional employees, providing for day-to-day substitutes; and, in certification of teachers, further providing for substitute teaching permit for prospective teachers and for program of continuing professional education. (Representatives GLEIM, RYAN, PICKETT and others) – Education, March 17, 2021

VOTE



This bill amends the Public School Code to provide school entities with day-to-day substitute teacher flexibility.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILLS

**HOUSE 416** 

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school health services, providing for seizure recognition and related first aid training. (Representatives QUINN, PICKETT, BROOKS and others) – Education, March 17, 2021

This bill amends the Public School Code to provide for seizure recognition and related first aid training.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

**HOUSE 359** 

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions, providing for exemption from taxation. (Representatives MARKOSEK, HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

HOUSE **385** 

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

**HOUSE 184** 

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in criminal homicide, further providing for the offense of causing or aiding suicide. (Representatives KEEFER, RYAN, ECKER and others) – Judiciary, February 26, 2021

This bill amends Title 18 to provide for the offense of causing or aiding suicide.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

HOUSE **881** 

A Joint Resolution proposing an emergency amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for courts to be open and suits against the Commonwealth. (Representative GREGORY) – Judiciary, March 16, 2021 2

OVER

This bill proposes an emergency amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for courts to be open and suits against the Commonwealth.

**SENATE** 

84

An Act amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, in district attorney, assistants and detectives, further providing for filling of vacancies. (Senators MARTIN, BAKER, BROWNE and others) – Judiciary, March 17, 2021

VOTE



This bill amends Section 1404(a) of the County Code relating to vacancies in the office of the district attorney in a county of the second class A through eight class.

**SENATE** 

85

An Act amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, in district attorney, assistants and detectives, further providing for filling of vacancies. (Senators MARTIN, BAKER, BROWNE and others) – Judiciary, March 17, 2021

VOTE



This bill amends Section 1404 (a) of the Second Class County Code relating to vacancies in the Office of District Attorney.

SENATE

86

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions relating to home rule and optional plan government, further providing for limitation on municipal powers. (Senators MARTIN, BAKER, BROWNE and others) – Judiciary, March 17, 2021

VOTE



This bill amends Section 2962(a) of Title 53 to remove the ability of counties with home rule charters to alter the procedure for filing a vacancy in the office of District Attorney.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

SENATE 27

An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; in child protective services, providing for task force on child pornography; and, in sentencing, further providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of children. (Senators BAKER, ARNOLD, VOGEL and others) - Judiciary, March 17, 2021

VOTE

This bill amends Title 18 and Title 42 to provide for enhanced sentencing of defendants convicted of child pornography if the child victim is under 10 years of age or prepubescent and further amends Title 23 to create the Task Force on Child Pornography.

### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE 112

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions relating to operation of vehicles, further providing for obedience to authorized persons directing traffic and providing for drivers in organized motorcycle processions; and, in rules of the road in general, further providing for following too closely. (Representatives STAMBAUGH, BOBACK, SCHLEGEL CULVER and others) - Transportation, March 17, 2021

VOTE

This bill amends Title 75 to provide rules for organized motorcycle processions.

HOUSE **148** 

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 25488, carrying State Route 1011 over the Mix Creek, Eldred Township, McKean County, as the Sgt. Neil K. Dorrion Memorial Bridge. (Representatives CAUSER, ARMANINI, BURNS and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

**OVER** 

This bill designates a bridge carrying State Route 1011 over the Mix Creek, Eldred Township, McKean County, as the Sgt. Neil K. Dorrion Memorial Bridge.

**HOUSE 149** 

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 39504, carrying Pennsylvania Route 3004 over the Allegheny River, Roulette Township, Potter County, as the SSG Gerrith Kibbe Memorial Bridge. (Representatives CAUSER, BURNS, CONKLIN and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021 5

OVER

This bill designates a bridge carrying Pennsylvania Route 3004 over the Allegheny River, Roulette Township, Potter County, as the SSG Gerrith Kibbe Memorial Bridge.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE **150** 

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8391, on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman **2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge.** (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman 2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge.

**HOUSE** 

**151** 

An Act designating the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills 116 Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway. (Representatives SANCHEZ, BURNS, others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021 5

OVER

This bill designates the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.

HOUSE **152** 

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, **KINSEY** others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021 5

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.
