SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 755

An Act amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in food protection, further providing for rules and regulations. (Representatives DAY, BURGOS, CAUSER and others) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, March 23, 2021

OVER

This bill requires food establishments producing bottled water to comply with federal and state requirements.

SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) – Education, March 17, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

HOUSE 754

An Act amending the act of May 1, 1984 (P.L.206, No.43), known as the Pennsylvania Safe Drinking Water Act, further providing for definitions. (Representatives DAY, BURGOS, CAUSER and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, March 23, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Safe Drinking Water Act to exclude facilities that bottle water for human consumption registered with the Department of Agriculture as food establishments from the definition of a "public water system".

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

HOUSE 359

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions, providing for exemption from taxation. (Representatives MARKOSEK, HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

HOUSE 385

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LIQUOR CONTROL BILLS

HOUSE

An Act amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, in licenses and regulations and liquor, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages, further providing for sales by liquor licensees and restrictions. (Representatives DOWLING, PICKETT, ROTHMAN and others) – Liquor Control, March 24, 2021

This bill provides for sales by liquor licensees and restrictions.

HOUSE 427

An Act amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known as the Liquor Code, in Pennsylvania liquor stores, further providing for sales by Pennsylvania liquor stores. (Representatives PYLE, WHEELAND, SCHMITT and others) – Liquor Control, March 24, 2021

HOUSE

OVER

This is a Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, providing for spending limitations on the Commonwealth.

HOUSE 335

An Act amending the act of April 13, 1887 (P.L.21, No.18), entitled "An act for the establishment of a uniform standard of time throughout the Commonwealth," observing daylight saving time year-around if authorized by the Congress of the United States. (Representatives R. MACKENZIE, DeLUCA, KAUFFMAN and others) - State Government, March 24, 2021

HOUSE 149

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 39504, carrying Pennsylvania Route 3004 over the Allegheny River, Roulette Township, Potter County, as the SSG Gerrith Kibbe Memorial Bridge. (Representatives CAUSER, BURNS, CONKLIN and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge carrying Pennsylvania Route 3004 over the Allegheny River, Roulette Township, Potter County, as the SSG Gerrith Kibbe Memorial Bridge.

HOUSE 150

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8391, on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman 2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman 2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge.

HOUSE

151

An Act designating the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway. (Representatives SANCHEZ, BURNS, RYAN and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.

HOUSE **152**

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.

SECOND CONSIDERATION URBAN AFFAIRS BILLS

An Act amending the act of July 7, 1947 (P.L.1368, No.542), known as the Real Estate Tax Sale Law, adding provisions relating to bidder registration before sale; and, in sale of property, further providing for date of sale, for repurchase by owner, for restrictions on purchases and for sale of property in repository. (Representatives HEFFLEY, WHEELAND, STRUZZI and others) – Urban Affairs, March 24, 2021



This bill amends RETSL to create a new provision requiring pre-registration of potential bidders at a tax sale.

An Act amending Title 72 (Taxation and Fiscal Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, establishing microenterprise loan programs and abating real property assessment. (Representatives GILLESPIE, HILL-EVANS, ROTHMAN and others) – Urban Affairs, March 24, 2021



This bill establishes the microenterprise loan program.

THIRD CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

SENATE 87

An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; in child protective services, providing for task force on child pornography; and, in sentencing, further providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of children. (Senators BAKER, ARNOLD, VOGEL and others) - Appropriations, March 22, 2021 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill amends Titles 18 and Title 42 to provide for enhanced sentencing of defendants convicted of child pornography if the child victim is under 10 years of age or prepubescent and further amends Title 23 to create the Task Force on Child Pornography.
