SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) – Education, March 17, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

HOUSE 359

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions, providing for exemption from taxation. (Representatives MARKOSEK, HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

385

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

HOUSE **766**

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in corporate net income tax, further providing for reports and payment of tax and for extension of time to file reports. (Representatives GREINER, ROTHMAN, RYAN and others) - Finance, April 06, 2021

VOTE



This bill provides for the Pennsylvania Corporate Tax Return Due Date.

SECOND CONSIDERATION GAMING OVERSIGHT BILL

HOUSE **290**

An Act amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, in miscellaneous provisions, providing for games of chance operations during COVID-19 disaster emergency. (Representatives WARNER, REESE, DAVANZO and others) - Gaming Oversight, April 06, 2021

VOTE



This bill amends the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act to provide for the operation of games and electronic payments during the COVID-19 pandemic emergency.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 951

An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in matters affecting government unites, further providing for exceptions to sovereign immunity and for exceptions to governmental immunity; and making a repeal. (Representative ROZZI) – Judiciary, April 05, 2021 2

VOLE

This bill amends Title 42 to provide that waivers of sovereign and governmental immunity for civil actions alleging sexual abuse of a minor shall apply retroactively.

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, providing for miscellaneous provisions and for recovery audits. (Representatives GROVE, PICKETT, THOMAS and others) – State Government, April 06, 2021



HOUSE

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 37135, located on Pennsylvania Route 92 over the Susquehanna River, Falls Township, Wyoming County, as the Falls Veterans Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BOBACK, CAUSER, BURNS and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021

This bill designates a bridge located on Pennsylvania Route 92 over the Susquehanna River, Falls Township, Wyoming County, as the Falls Veterans Memorial Bridge.



This bill designates a bridge carrying State Route 1002 over the West Branch of the Susquehanna River, Castanea Township, Clinton County, as the Petty Officer Stephen "Turbo" Toboz, Jr., Bridge.

HOUSE 929

An Act designating a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout. (Representatives STAMBAUGH, BURNS, CONKLIN and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021 2

OVER

This bill designates a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout.

SENATE 96

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania
Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing
for contributions to Veterans' Trust Fund. (Senators ROBINSON,
MARTIN, BARTOLOTTA and others) - Transportation, April 5,
2021

OVER

This bill increases contribution amounts to the Veterans Trust Fund.

An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; in child protective services, providing for task force on child pornography; and, in sentencing, further providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of children. (Senators BAKER, ARNOLD, VOGEL and others) - Appropriations, March 22, 2021 Fiscal-Note Attached

OVER

This bill amends Titles 18 and Title 42 to provide for enhanced sentencing of defendants convicted of child pornography if the child victim is under 10 years of age or prepubescent and further amends Title 23 to create the Task Force on Child Pornography.
