SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 1161 1284

An Act providing for local solar program, for renewable energy credits and for powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. (Representatives MIZGORSKI, BROOKS, ECKER and others) – Consumer Affairs, April 21, 2021

C VOTE

This bill creates the PA Local Solar Program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

HOUSE 232

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) – Education, March 17, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

HOUSE **359**

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions, providing for exemption from taxation. (Representatives MARKOSEK, HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

HOUSE 385

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) - Finance, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILL

681

An Act prohibiting enforcement of covenants not to compete in health care practitioner employment agreements. (Representatives ECKER, BROOKS, BERNSTINE and others) - Health, April 21, 2021

C

This bill establishes the free-standing Health Care Practitioner Noncompete Agreement Act.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HUMAN SERVICES BILL

HOUSE 1017

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, further providing for medical assistance payments for institutional care. (Representatives O'NEAL, DELOZIER, FARRY and others) - Human Services, April 21, 2021

OVER

This bill amends the Human Services Code to provide for additional payment allocations for eligible Medical Assistance ventilatory or tracheostomy patients.

SECOND CONSIDERATION PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE BILLS

HOUSE 609

An Act amending the act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.913, No.367), known as the Engineer, Land Surveyor and Geologist Registration 1281 Law, further providing for definitions, for procedure for licensing as professional engineer, for continuing professional competency requirements and for exemption from licensure and registration. EMRICK, **JOZWIAK** (Representatives HELM, and others) - Professional Licensure, April 21, 2021

This bill updates the Engineer, Land Surveyor and Geologist Registration Law.

HOUSE 855

An Act amending Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed)) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and duties, providing for application form for licenses, certificates, registrations and permits. (Representatives OWLETT, SAYLOR, ZIMMERMAN and others) - Professional Licensure, April 21, 2021

This bill requires BPOA to provide paper applications under certain circumstances.

HOUSE 71

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, providing for spending limitations on the Commonwealth. WARNER, (Representatives DAVANZO, **DIAMOND** others) - State Government, March 22, 2021

OVER

This is a Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in taxation and finance, providing for spending limitations on the Commonwealth.

Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) – Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 53 over Laurel Run, also known as Lost Creek, in Dean Township, Cambria County, as the Seaman 2nd Class Louis J. Benzie WWII Memorial Bridge.

HOUSE 151

An Act designating the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway. (Representatives SANCHEZ, BURNS, RYAN and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021 14

OVER

This bill designates the portion of State Route 2038, also known as Fitzwatertown Road, between Jenkintown Road and North Hills Avenue in Upper Dublin Township, Montgomery County, as the CPL Vincent J. Wargo, Jr., U.S.M.C. Memorial Highway.

HOUSE 152

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 43267, on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge. (Representatives BURNS, GUENST, KINSEY and others) - Transportation, February 26, 2021

OVER

This bill designates a bridge on that portion of State Route 3041, also known as Dishong Mountain Road, over U.S. Route 22 in Jackson Township, Cambria County, as the Technical Sergeant Mike Capelli Memorial Bridge.

Troutman Memorial Roundabout. (Representatives STAMBAUGH, BURNS, CONKLIN and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021 This bill designates a roundabout at Pennsylvania Route 34, Spring Road, Pennsylvania Route 850, Valley Road, and Pisgah State Road in Carroll Township, Perry County, as the Shane E. Troutman Memorial Roundabout. **HOUSE** An Act designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 981 from OVER the intersection with Pennsylvania Route 819 to the intersection 1132 with State Route 2021 in Mount Pleasant Township, Westmoreland

This bill designates a bridge in Cambria County as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge.

OVER

This bill establishes requirements for the permitted movement of dozer blades.

An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; in child protective services, providing for task force on child pornography; and, in sentencing, further providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of children.
