SECOND CONSIDERATION **AGING AND OLDER ADULT SERVICES BILL**

HOUSE An Act providing for access to long-term care facilities for members of the clergy, for additional safety requirements for 1414 residents, for suspension of access for members of the clergy and for personal protective equipment for members of the clergy. (Representatives DAVANZO, T. DAVIS, HENNESSEY and others) - Aging & Older Adult Services, May 25, 2021 1



This bill provides for access to long-term care facilities for members of the clergy, for additional safety requirements for residents, for suspension of access for members of the clergy and for personal protective equipment for members of the clergy.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **EDUCATION BILL**



996

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school districts, further 844 providing for how constituted. (Representatives MUSTELLO, STRUZZI, ROWE and others) - Education, March 17, 2021 15

This bill amends the Public School Code to permit a school district to change its name.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS



An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176),
 known as The Fiscal Code, in emergency finance and tax provisions,
 providing for exemption from taxation. (Representatives MARKOSEK,
 HILL-EVANS, A. DAVIS and others) – Finance, May 4, 2021 4

OVER

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to exclude economic recovery payments issued under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from consideration as income, earned income or taxable income.

HOUSE 385

An Act amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, in personal income tax, further providing for classes of income. (Representatives DUNBAR, ROTHMAN, BROOKS and others) – Finance, May 4, 2021 4

OVER

This bill amends the Tax Reform Code to exclude an amount of loan forgiveness granted under the Federal Coronavirus Aid Act or the Federal Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, from state income tax.

SECOND CONSIDERATION GAME AND FISHERIES BILLS

453 An Act amending Titles 30 (Fish) and 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fishing licenses, providing for active duty military fishing reciprocity and for disabled veteran annual fishing license reciprocity; and, in hunting and furtaking licenses, providing for active duty military hunting reciprocity and for disabled veteran annual hunting license reciprocity. (Representatives BOBACK, RYAN, HILL-EVANS and others) - Game & Fisheries, May 25, 2021

This bill provides for reciprocity between the Commonwealth and other states for active duty military personnel hunting and fishing licenses.


HOUSE 1122 1170 An Act amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further providing for resident license and fee exemptions and for license costs and fees. (Representatives GILLESPIE, BOBACK, ZIMMERMAN and others) - Game & Fisheries, May 25, 2021 1

This bill provides for a discounted general hunting license for Hunter Trapper Education Instructors.





SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS





This bill amends the Municipalities Planning Code to establish procedures and rules for nonbuilding lots as part of municipalities' Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances.



An Act amending the act of January 19, 1968 (1967 P.L.992, No.442), entitled "An act authorizing the Commonwealth of 188 Pennsylvania and the local government units thereof to preserve, acquire or hold land for open space uses," further providing for local taxing options. (Representatives RADER, FREEMAN, MILLARD and others) - Local Government, May 25, 2021



This bill provides to allow local governments to properly maintain open space land regardless of the way the land was acquired.



This bill amends the Consolidated County Assessment Law to further facilitate the existing statutory requirement that building permit information be submitted to the county assessment office.

HOUSE 184 An Act amending Title 8 (Boroughs and Incorporated Towns) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in associations and 1450 organizations, further providing for associations and organizations for mayors; in elections of officers, further providing for eligibility; in powers, duties and rights of appointed officers and employees, further providing for appointments and incompatible offices and for police serving under cooperative agreement or contract; in corporate powers, further providing for specific powers; in taxation and finance, further providing for investment of funds; providing for solid waste collection and disposition; and, in ordinances, further providing for ordinances and resolutions and for publication. (Representatives MOUL, JAMES, KNOWLES and others) - Local Government, May 25, 2021 1

This bill makes various technical changes and clarifications to the Borough Code.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILLS



An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions relating to home rule and optional plan government, further providing for definitions, providing for appointment of government study commission in distressed municipality and further providing for first meeting of commission, for function and duty of commission, for hearings and public forums, for report of findings and recommendations, for limitation on enactment of ordinance or filing of petition and for limitation on municipal powers. (Representatives JAMES, MOUL, KNOWLES and others) - Local Government, May 25, 2021

This bill amends the Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law to allow a distressed municipality to form a government study commission directly and include a specific role for the Act 47 coordinator study and recommendation process.

SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE 37 An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 1019 definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for learners' permits and for examination of applicant for driver's license; in rules of the road in general, further providing for prohibiting text-based communications, providing for prohibiting use of interactive wireless communications devices and imposing penalties; and, in operation of vehicles miscellaneous provisions, further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle and for the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle. (Representatives R. BROWN, MALAGARI, BOBACK and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021 11

This bill bans the use of handheld cellphones while driving.

An Act designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 8556, carrying SR 1008 (Eckenrode Mill Road) over Chest Creek, located 228 in East Carroll Township, Cambria County, as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge. (Senator LANGERHOLC) - Transportation, April 19, 2021 8

This bill designates a bridge in Cambria County as the Kenneth John Ivory Memorial Bridge.

SENATE 96 An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania OVER Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing 229 for contributions to Veterans' Trust Fund. (Senators ROBINSON, MARTIN, BARTOLOTTA and others) - Transportation, April 5, 2021 11

This bill increases contribution amounts to the Veterans Trust Fund.

SENATE An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing 91 for conditions of permits and security for damages. (Senator TOMLINSON) - Transportation, April 19, 2021 8

This bill establishes requirements for the permitted movement of dozer blades.

An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses), 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the offense of sexual abuse of children; in child protective services, providing for task force on child pornography; and, in sentencing, further providing for sentencing for offenses involving sexual abuse of children. (Senators BAKER, ARNOLD, VOGEL and others) - Appropriations, March 22, 2021 Fiscal-Note Attached 14

This bill amends Titles 18 and Title 42 to provide for enhanced sentencing of defendants convicted of child pornography if the child victim is under 10 years of age or prepubescent and further amends Title 23 to create the Task Force on Child Pornography.
