## SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILLS

## HOUSE

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution 4 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for courts
4 to be open and suits against the Commonwealth. (Representatives ROZZI, McCLINTON, BRADFORD and others) - Judiciary, March 6, 2023

This bill places a Constitutional Amendment on the ballot to provide a two year window for victims of childhood sexual abuse to bring previously barred claims.

2 An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in limitation of time,
5 further providing for infancy, insanity or imprisonment; in matters affecting government units, further providing for exceptions to sovereign immunity and for exceptions to governmental immunity; and making a repeal. (Representatives ROZZI, McCLINTON, BRADFORD and others) - Judiciary, March 6, 2023

This bill provides childhood sexual abuse victims a two year window to seek justice and waives sovereign and governmental immunity in such cases.

to be open and suits against the Commonwealth. (Senators LAUGHLIN, J. WARD, K. WARD and others) - Judiciary, March 6, 2023


This bill places a Constitutional Amendment on the ballot to provide a two year window for victims of childhood sexual abuse to bring previously barred claims.
