

An Act amending the act of March 28, 1984 (P.L.150, No.28), known as the Automobile Lemon Law, further providing for definitions, for repair obligations, for manufacturer's duty for refund or replacement and for presumption of a reasonable number of attempts. (Representatives PISCIOTTANO, MADDEN, D. WILLIAMS and others) - Consumer Protection, Technology & Utilities, April 26, 2023



This bill extends the automobile Lemon Law coverage to motorcycles.

SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILLS

HOUSE **100**

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in terms and courses of study, providing for cross-age tutoring program. (Representatives FREEMAN, SANCHEZ, HILL-EVANS and others) – Education, April 26, 2023



This bill requires the State Board of Education to establish a "Tutoring Program" whereby students in eleventh and twelfth grades may tutor pupils in grades one through six.




This bill extends Municipal Tax Claims and Lien Law to cities and counties of the second class.

HOUSE 735


An Act establishing the Flood Insurance Premium Assistance Task Force. (Representatives WARREN, BURGOS, MADDEN and others) - Insurance, April 26, 2023



This bill establishes the Flood Insurance Premium Assistance Task Force.

HOUSE 739

An Act amending Title 40 (Insurance) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in regulation of insurers and related persons generally, providing for insurance data security; in reserve liabilities, repealing provisions relating to small company exemption and providing for adoption of exemption standards of NAIC Valuation Manual; and imposing penalties. (Representatives BOYLE, PICKETT, HILL-EVANS and others) – Insurance, April 26, 2023




This bill Amends Title 40 to require insurance entities to develop cybersecurity policies and report cybersecurity events to the Insurance Commissioner.

HOUSE **115**

An Act amending Title 20 (Decedents, Estates and Fiduciaries)
of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in dispositions
independent of letters, family exemption, probate of wills and grant
of letters, further providing for payments to family and funeral
directors. (Representatives CIRESI, HILL-EVANS, MADDEN and
others) - Judiciary, April 26, 2023



This bill expands the groups of people who can claim unclaimed property of a deceased family member.

300 1020

An Act amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act, further providing for the title of the act, for findings and declaration of policy, for right to freedom from discrimination in employment, housing and public accommodation, for definitions, for unlawful discriminatory practices and for prohibition of certain real estate practices; providing for protection of religious exercise; and further providing for powers and duties of commission, for educational program and for construction and exclusiveness of remedy. (Representatives KENYATTA, BENHAM, FRANKEL and others) – Judiciary, April 26, 2023



This bill extends the protection in the Human Relations Act to include sexual orientation and gender identity and expression.
