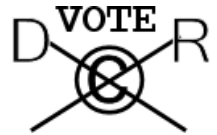

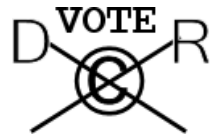

*This bill establishes a "Grow Our Own Educators" program in Pennsylvania.*

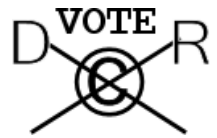

*This bill extends Municipal Tax Claims and Lien Law to cities and counties of the second class.*

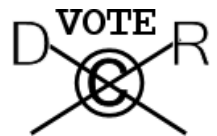

*This bill expands the groups of people who can claim unclaimed property of a deceased family member.*

**1020** An Act amending the act of October 27, 1955 (P.L.744, No.222), known as the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act, further providing for the title of the act, for findings and declaration of policy, for right to freedom from discrimination in employment, housing and public accommodation, for definitions, for unlawful discriminatory practices and for prohibition of certain real estate practices; providing for protection of religious exercise; and further providing for powers and duties of commission, for educational program and for construction and exclusiveness of remedy. (Representatives KENYATTA, BENHAM, FRANKEL and others) – Judiciary, April 26, 2023 **1**
