SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

HOUSE 953 An Act repealing the act of September 1, 1965 (P.L.420, No.215), known as The Frozen Dessert Law. (Representatives WENTLING, PASHINSKI, MOUL and others) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, May 3,2023 1



This bill repeals the Frozen Dessert Law.

An Act amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; and, in taxation by school districts, further providing for school district tax notices. (Representatives PASHINSKI, HARKINS, SANCHEZ and others) - Finance, May 2, 2023 2

This bill clarifies the notice for Homestead and Farmstead property tax relief on property tax bills.

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, providing for report of theft or loss of firearm; and imposing penalties. (Representatives SANCHEZ, KENYATTA, MADDEN and others) - Judiciary, May 3, 2023



This bill amends Title 18 to provide for the reporting of theft or loss of firearm.

HOUSE 714 660 An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, repealing provisions relating to sale or transfer of firearms. (Representatives WARREN, VITALI, ZABEL and others) - Judiciary, May 3, 2023 1

This bill amends Title 18 repealing provisions relating to sale or transfer of firearms.

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for locking device for firearms; providing for safe storage of firearm when not in use; and imposing penalties. (Representatives PARKER, HOHENSTEIN, RABB and others) - Judiciary, May 3, 2023

This bill amends Title 18 providing for locking devices for firearms.

HOUSE 917 905 An Act amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, adopting the Uniform Family Law Arbitration Act. (Representatives SHUSTERMAN, T. DAVIS, MADDEN and others) – Judiciary, May 3, 2023 1

This bill amends Title 42 of the PA Consolidated Statutes, adopting the Uniform Family Law Arbitration Act.

HOUSE 1018 960 An Act amending Titles 18 (Crimes and Offenses) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous articles, further providing for persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer firearms and for abandonment of firearms, weapons or ammunition; in community and municipal courts, further providing for masters; adding provisions relating to extreme risk protection orders; imposing duties on the Office of Attorney General; and imposing penalties. (Representatives O'MARA, FRANKEL, GUENST and others) - Judiciary, May 3, 2023 1

This bill amends Title 18 and 42 providing for persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer firearms and for abandonment of firearms, weapons or ammunition, in community and municipal courts, further providing for masters.
