SECOND CONSIDERATION APPROPRIATIONS BILL

HOUSE 611

An Act to provide appropriations from the General Fund for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of 1120 the Commonwealth, the public debt and the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023; to provide appropriations from special funds and accounts to the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, and for the payment of bills remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023; to provide for the appropriation of Federal funds to the Executive and Judicial Departments for the fiscal year July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024, and for the payment of bills remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023; and to provide for the additional appropriation of Federal and State funds to the Executive and Legislative Departments for the fiscal year July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, **2022.** (Representative HARRIS) - Appropriations, 2023

VOTE

This bill makes both state and federal appropriations for the expenses of the executive, legislative and judicial branches of government during the 2023-2024 fiscal year.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **COMMERCE BILLS**

HOUSE

An Act establishing the Keystone Saves Program, the Keystone Saves Program Fund, the Keystone Saves Administrative Fund and 1137 the Keystone Saves Program Advisory Board; and providing for powers and duties of the Treasury Department, for investment and fiduciary responsibilities and for program implementation. (Representatives MULLINS, GALLAGHER, others) - Commerce, May 23, 2023 1



This bill established the Keystone Saves Program.

HOUSE 922

An Act amending Title 64 (Public Authorities and Quasi-Public Corporations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in 1138 Commonwealth Financing Authority, further providing for Second Stage Loan Program. (Representatives SHUSTERMAN, SANCHEZ, MADDEN and others) - Commerce, May 23, 2023

This bill amends Title 64 to streamline the Second Stage Loan Program.

SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILLS

HOUSE 804

An Act amending the act of December 15, 1982 (P.L.1266, No.287), entitled "An act conferring limited residency status on 762 military personnel, their dependents and civilian personnel assigned to an active duty station in Pennsylvania," further providing for residency of students. (Representatives BURNS, RABB, BOYLE and others) - Education, May 23, 2023

This bill guarantees in-state tuition at public institutions of higher education in PA for dependents of military members, veterans & civilian defense employees in cases where the family relocates between the time a student accepts admission & the start of the first semester.

HOUSE

1094

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in pupils and attendance, providing for military child advance enrollment. (Representatives MUNROE, M. MACKENZIE, BRENNAN and others) - Education, May 23, 2023



This bill allows for the advance enrollment of military children.

SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILL

HOUSE 178

An Act amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; and, in taxation by school districts, further providing for school district tax notices. (Representatives PASHINSKI, HARKINS, SANCHEZ and others) - Finance, May 2, 2023

OVER

This bill clarifies the notice for Homestead and Farmstead property tax relief on property tax bills.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 95

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in nuisances, further providing for the offense of scattering rubbish. (Representatives BULLOCK, BURGOS, GIRAL and others) – Judiciary, May 23, 2023 1
