#### SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER PROTECTION, TECHNOLOGY AND UTILITIES BILL

HOUSE 1028 1025

An Act amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in railroads, providing for prohibition on blocking of crossings, for limitation on length of freight or work trains, for authorization to monitor safety practices and operations by collective bargaining representatives, for safe staffing levels for trains or light engines, for wayside detector systems, for study of transportation of hazardous materials or waste and for reporting system for transportation of hazardous materials or waste; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MATZIE, MARSHALL, NEILSON and others) - Consumer Protection, Technology & Utilities, May 24, 2023

This bill amends Title 66 providing for comprehensive rail safety.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION EDUCATION BILL

HOUSE 1097 1288

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in terms and courses of study, providing for moment of silence on September 11 anniversary. (Representatives HADDOCK, SCHWEYER, MADDEN and others) - Education, May 24, 2023

VOTE

This bill provides courses of study and a moment of silence for the anniversary of the September 11th, 2001 terror attacks.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION FINANCE BILLS

HOUSE 178 1031

An Act amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; and, in taxation by school districts, further providing for school district tax notices. (Representatives PASHINSKI, HARKINS, SANCHEZ and others) - Finance, May 2, 2023

**OVER** 

This bill clarifies the notice for Homestead and Farmstead property tax relief on property tax bills.

HOUSE 1100 1148

An Act amending the act of June 27, 2006 (1st Sp.Sess., P.L.1873, No.1), known as the Taxpayer Relief Act, in tax relief in cities of the first class, further providing for supplemental senior citizen tax reduction; and, in senior citizens property tax and rent rebate assistance, further providing for property tax and rent rebate and for filing of claim. (Representatives SAMUELSON, KIM, SMITH-WADE-EL and others) - Finance, May 24, 2023



This bill expands the Property Tax Rebate Program.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE **689** 

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in criminal history record information, further providing for definitions, for general regulations, for petition for limited access, for clean slate limited access, for exceptions, for effects of expunged records and records subject to limited access and for employer immunity from liability. (Representatives HARRIS, DELOZIER, FRANKEL and others) - Judiciary, May 24, 2023

VOTE

This bill amends Title 18 in criminal history record information.

## SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

HOUSE 1031 1047

An Act designating the boat access located on the West Branch of the Susquehanna River in Muncy Creek Township, Lycoming County, as the Representative Garth Everett Muncy Access Area. (Representatives HAMM, MALONEY, DUNBAR and others) - Transportation, May 24, 2023

CO VOLE

This bill designates the boat access located on the West Branch of the Susquehanna River in Muncy Creek Township, Lycoming County, as the Representative Garth Everett Muncy Access Area.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION TRANSPORTATION BILLS

**HOUSE** 1162

An Act amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, in special funds, providing for Public 1213 Safety and Protection Fund; and, in general budget implementation, further providing for Motor License Fund. (Representatives NEILSON, BENNINGHOFF, HILL-EVANS others) - Transportation, May 24, 2023

 $\mathbf{VOTE}$ 

This bill amends the Fiscal Code to establish the Public Safety and Protection Fund and to gradually reduce the appropriation to the State Police Motor License Fund.

#### SECOND CONSIDERATION **VETERANS AFFAIRS & EMERGENCY PREP. BILL**

**HOUSE 479** 

Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public welfare 1092 laws of the Commonwealth," in public assistance, providing for ambulance transportation services. (Representatives BOROWSKI, SCOTT, HILL-EVANS and others) - Veterans Affairs & Emergency Preparedness, May 24, 2023



This bill requires that an ambulance must travel 20 miles with a patient on board before medical assistance will reimburse for the service.

#### THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE **JUDICIARY BILL**

HOUSE

An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous 1091 articles, further providing for locking device for firearms; providing for safe storage of firearm when not in use; and imposing penalties. (Representatives PARKER, HOHENSTEIN, others) - Appropriations, May 22, 2023 Fiscal-Note Attached 3

OVER

This bill amends Title 18 providing for locking devices for firearms.
