SECOND CONSIDERATION AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS BILL

SENATE **694**

An Act amending Title 3 (Agriculture) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fireworks, further providing for definitions, for sales locations and for Attorney General. (Senators FARRY AND BROWN) - Agriculture & Rural Affairs, October 05, 2023

OVER

This bill repeals outdated provisions to the Fireworks Law.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER PROTECTION, TECHNOLOGY AND UTILITIES BILL

HOUSE 109

An Act prohibiting fees for early termination of certain contracts upon death; providing for waiver of applicable fees; and imposing civil penalties. (Representatives CIRESI, HILL-EVANS, HOHENSTEIN and others) - Consumer Protection, Technology & Utilities, October 05, 2023

OVER

This bill prohibits early termination fees for deceased individuals.

SECOND CONSIDERATION ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY BILL

HOUSE **1474**

An Act amending Title 12 (Commerce and Trade) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Property Assessed Clean Energy Program, further providing for purpose and for definitions. (Representatives CIRESI, HILL-EVANS, MADDEN and others) - Environmental Resources & Energy, October 4, 2023 2

OVER

This bill expands C-PACE to include electric vehicle charging infrastructure.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HUMAN SERVICES BILL

876

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in fraud and abuse control, further providing for definitions, for restrictions on provider charges and payments and for venue and limitations on actions. (Representatives CABELL AND GROVE) - Rules, October 3, 2023

OVER

This bill provides for charges and payments and for venue and limitations on actions.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1297

An Act amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in employees, providing for ballistic armor for law enforcement officers. (Representatives A. BROWN, BRENNAN, ROZZI and others) - Rules, June 28, 2023

OVER

This bill requires police to wear ballistic body armor for protection during high risk law enforcement activities and provides training.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 1465 1649

An Act providing for minimum wage standards in underground infrastructure work, for application of Prevailing Wage Act, for enforcement, for penalties and appeals and for protection from retaliation; and creating a private right of action. (Representatives DELLOSO, MADDEN, McNEILL and others) - Rules, June 29, 2023

OVER

This bill provides for Prevailing Wage for underground utility projects.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LIQUOR CONTROL BILL

HOUSE 1252 1688

An Act amending the act of June 9, 1936 (Sp.Sess.1, P.L.13, No.4), entitled "An act imposing an emergency State tax on liquor, as herein defined, sold by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the collection and payment of such tax; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue and the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board," further providing for emergency tax on liquors and amount of tax and collection. (Representatives BENHAM, MADDEN, SANCHEZ and others) - Rules, June 28, 2023

OVER

This bill creates a grant program to provide financial support for municipalities that are in the greatest need of additional public safety measures and violent crime reduction efforts respective of their high concentration of liquor licenses.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 1303 1429

An Act amending Title 11 (Cities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in mayor, further providing for execution of laws, powers of sheriff conferred and emergency powers. (Representatives SIEGEL, HILL-EVANS, SCHLOSSBERG and others) - Rules, June 28, 2023

OVER

This bill would amend the Third Class City Code to update the emergency powers provisions pertaining to the length of the duration of a declared emergency by the mayor.

SECOND CONSIDERATION PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE BILL

HOUSE 1490 2083

An Act amending the act of February 14, 1986 (P.L.2, No.2), known as the Acupuncture Licensure Act, further providing for definitions, for regulation of the practice of acupuncture, for penalties and for approval of acupuncture educational programs. (Representatives GALLAGHER, HILL-EVANS, MADDEN and others) - Professional Licensure, October 05, 2023

OVER

This bill amends the Acupuncture Licensure Act to provide title protection, establish an emergency exemption and require continuing education.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE An Act amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the **1278** OVER Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in wiretapping and electronic surveillance, further providing for definitions and for exceptions to prohibition of interception and disclosure of communications, providing for public access and for Department of Corrections retention policy and further providing for expiration of chapter. (Representatives PIELLI, BRIGGS, **MADDEN** others) - Appropriations, September 27, 2023 Fiscal-Note **Attached** This bill removes certain communications made in the presence of the state parole agents and persons holding a police officer commission employed by the Department of Corrections from the definition of "oral communication" under the Wiretap Act and extends the Wiretap Act until 2029.
