

Veto No. 1978-3

To the Honorable, the House of Representatives
of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

I return herewith, without my approval, House Bill No. 1277, Printer's No. 1500, entitled "An act making an appropriation to the Dickinson School of Law, Carlisle, Pennsylvania."

This bill would appropriate \$99,000 to Dickinson Law School.

The Commonwealth remains in a financially restricted situation in spite of the tax increases passed in December 1977. In order to assure the continuing operation of State programs, I cannot approve this non-preferred appropriation to the only law school in the Commonwealth to receive such preferential treatment.
