SECOND CONSIDERATION **EDUCATION BILLS**

HOUSE An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school health services, 3070 providing for Menstrual Hygiene Products Accessibility Grant Program; and making an appropriation. (Representatives PARKER, 3, HILL-EVANS, MADDEN and others) - Education, June 2024 1

This bill creates a grant program to provide eligible public-school entities with funding to acquire and distribute menstrual hygiene products at no expense to students.

HOUSE 1367

An Act amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, in school health services, 3071 providing for student mental health awareness. (Representatives DALEY, MADDEN, HILL-EVANS and others) - Education, June 3, 2024

This bill provides for mental health awareness for student athletes, parents, guardians, and coaches.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HEALTH BILL



An Act amending the act of June 13, 2008 (P.L.182, No.27), known as the Clean Indoor Air Act, further providing for title of act, for definitions, for prohibition, for signage, for enforcement, for preemption of local ordinances and for repeal; and making editorial changes. (Representatives FRANKEL, RABB, D. WILLIAMS and others) - Health, April 17, 2024 11

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

SECOND CONSIDERATION HUMAN SERVICES BILL

HOUSE 2137 2823 An Act amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for maternal and newborn supply kit; and establishing the Maternal and Newborn Supply Kit Fund. (Representatives MAYES, CURRY, ISAACSON and others) - Human Services, May 20, 2024 4

This bill establishes the Maternal and Newborn and Supply Kit Program under the Department of Health.

SECOND CONSIDERATION INSURANCE BILLS

HOUSEAn Act prohibiting discrimination in certain life insurance policies1021based on certain drugs. (Representatives SANCHEZ, CURRY,
DELLOSO and others) - Insurance, May 22, 2024

This bill prohibits life insurers from discriminating against an applicant or enrollee who obtained an opioid overdose reversal agent, such as Naloxone.

HOUSE 1867 3054 An Act amending Title 40 (Insurance) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in regulation of insurers and related persons generally, providing for payment choice; and imposing penalties. (Representatives VENKAT, SANCHEZ, KAZEEM and others) - Insurance, June 3, 2024 1

This bill requires dental insurers to provide dentists with multiple payment methods.

SECOND CONSIDERATION JUDICIARY BILL

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, further providing for false statements, investigations and penalty; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MAYES, D. MILLER, MADDEN and others) – Judiciary, April 17, 2024 11

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE 2235 2989 An Act providing for regulation of the meat packing and food processing industry by creating facility health and safety committees in the workplace; establishing the industry workers' rights coordinator within the Department of Labor and Industry; and providing for public health emergency protections for workers. (Representatives HADDOCK, KENYATTA, SANCHEZ and others) - Labor & Industry, May 22, 2024 2

This bill creates the Meat Processing and Food Packing Protection Act.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE TRANSPORTATION BILL

SENATE An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania 656 Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 1519 definitions; in liquid fuels and fuels tax, further providing for definitions and for imposition of tax, exemptions and deductions and providing for electric vehicle road user charge; and imposing penalty. (Senators ROTHMAN, DUSH, AND J. a WARD) - Appropriations, April 2024 **Fiscal-Note** 10. Attached 14

This bill imposes an annual fee of \$290 per year on certain noncommercial passenger electric vehicles and provides for the Alternative Fuels Tax on Electricity.




