SECOND CONSIDERATION **CHILDREN & YOUTH BILL**

HOUSE

An Act amending Titles 23 (Domestic Relations) and 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in proceedings prior to petition to adopt, further providing for grounds for involuntary termination; and, in juvenile matters, further providing for disposition of dependent child. (Representatives KRAJEWSKI, KINSEY, CONKLIN and others) - Children & Youth, March 27, 2024

This bill provides for grounds for involuntary termination in juvenile matters.

SECOND CONSIDERATION COMMERCE BILL

HOUSE

2174

An Act amending Title 64 (Public Authorities and Quasi-Public Corporations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in 2838 Commonwealth Financing Authority, providing for Mixed-Use Revitalization Program; and establishing the Mixed-Use **Revitalization Fund.** (Representatives FLEMING, HILL-EVANS, MADDEN and others) - Commerce, May 1, 2024

This bill establishes the Mixed-Use Revitalization Program to revitalize blighted commercial properties.

SECOND CONSIDERATION CONSUMER PROTECTION, TECHNOLOGY AND **UTILITIES BILL**

HOUSE 2017

An Act amending Title 50 (Mental Health) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for protection of minors on social media; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MUNROE, DONAHUE. BOROWSKI and others) - Consumer Protection. Technology & Utilities, March 25, 2024

This bill amends Title 50 to provide protections for minors using social media and imposing penalties.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **HEALTH BILLS**

HOUSE 1608

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, providing 2972 for medical assistance coverage for doula services. (Representatives CEPHAS, MADDEN, SANCHEZ and others) - Health, May 1, 2024

This bill provides for medical assistance reimbursement for doula services.

HOUSE

1657

An Act amending the act of June 13, 2008 (P.L.182, No.27), known as the Clean Indoor Air Act, further providing for title of 2317 act, for definitions, for prohibition, for signage, for enforcement, for preemption of local ordinances and for repeal; and making editorial changes. (Representatives FRANKEL, RABB, D. WILLIAMS and others) - Health, April 17, 2024

This bill protects Pennsylvania's workers, patrons and clients from secondhand smoke by closing loopholes in the Clean Indoor Air Act.

2097

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, providing for coverage for blood pressure monitors. (Representatives MAYES, KINKEAD, PROBST and others) - Health, May 1, 2024

This bill provides for medical assistance coverage for blood pressure monitors.

SECOND CONSIDERATION **JUDICIARY BILL**

HOUSE 1806

An Act amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, in public assistance, further providing for false statements, investigations and penalty; and imposing penalties. (Representatives MAYES, D. MILLER, MADDEN and others) - Judiciary, April 17, 2024

This bill increases the grading thresholds for welfare fraud to allow the Office of Inspector General to pursue a greater number of cases at the Magisterial District Justice level.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LABOR & INDUSTRY BILL

HOUSE

An Act amending the act of December 17, 1959 (P.L.1913, No.694), known as the Equal Pay Law, further providing for definitions and for wars not to the second secon definitions and for wage rates; providing for additional violations; further providing for powers of secretary, for collection of unpaid wages, for records and reporting and for penalties; and establishing the Equal Pay Enforcement Fund. (Representatives BULLOCK, ABNEY, SHUSTERMAN and others) - Labor & Industry, May 1, 2024

This bill amends and strengthens the Equal Pay Law.

SECOND CONSIDERATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT BILL

HOUSE 961

An Act amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in preliminary provisions, providing for county property contact information list; imposing duties on chief assessors; and providing for penalties. (Representatives SOLOMON, MERSKI, SIEGEL and others) - Local Government, March 19, 2024

This bill amends Title 68 to require individuals and businesses to submit basic information to counties when purchasing real property within the county.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE JUDICIARY BILL

HOUSE 1371

An Act providing for duties of certifying officials and certifying agencies regarding the processing of certification form petitions.

(Representatives HOHENSTEIN, MIHALEK, BURGOS and others) – Appropriations, March 26, 2024 Fiscal-Note Attached

This bill provides certifying agencies with clarity and consistency for providing nonimmigrant victims with documentation to use when applying for a U Visa.

THIRD CONSIDERATION AND FINAL PASSAGE TRANSPORTATION BILL

SENATE 656

An Act amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for definitions; in liquid fuels and fuels tax, further providing for definitions and for imposition of tax, exemptions and deductions and providing for electric vehicle road user charge; and imposing penalty. (Senators ROTHMAN, DUSH. **AND** WARD) - Appropriations, 2024 April 10. Fiscal-Note **Attached**

This bill imposes an annual fee of \$290 per year on certain noncommercial passenger electric vehicles and provides for the Alternative Fuels Tax on Electricity.
